



Expansion Progress Updates:

St. Charles Location:

- Ongoing Enhancements: The Saint Charles Campus external office building is currently undergoing much-needed repair and a fresh coat of paint.
- **Project Update:** Phase 2 of the project is in full swing, and permit approval for Phase 3 is in process.
- Future Plans: With everything on track, we aim to commence Phase 3 construction by October with a Fall 2025 completion.

Little Creek Location:

- Enhanced Cleanliness: Our roadways and parking lots are undergoing meticulous
 pressure washing, followed by fresh re-striping of all parking lanes and spots, ensuring
 a pristine and welcoming environment for all visitors.
- Worship Center Improvements: We have replaced all lights in the worship center with brand-new LED bulbs, resolving previous issues and significantly enhancing our TV and broadcast quality across all campuses.
- Advanced Production Equipment: The installation of state-of-the-art production equipment has been completed, elevating our capabilities to deliver top-notch productions and enhancing service experience online and in person.
- **Brand New CRM:** Our Relationship Management Systems are being upgraded to the latest technology, ensuring a more efficient, seamless, and user-friendly experience for our church family and staff.

West Esplanade Location:

- Early Learning Center: We are excited to announce that progress continues unabated toward the opening of our Early Learning Center (ELC). Preparations are underway, pending state permits and licensing.
- **Project Update:** While the roof installation has been successfully completed, the remaining gap to fully fund the capital projects in 2024 is \$271,619.
- Global Impact: The West Esplanade campus recently led a successful mission trip to Mexico City, Mexico, where the team provided vital services to the local community. Over the course of the mission, they served 413 medical patients, offered haircuts and nail care to 139 individuals, and engaged with 139 children through various activities. Remarkably, 196 people made decisions of faith during the trip.

Baton Rouge Location:

- **COTK Kids Remodel:** Drawings have been submitted to the city, and we are awaiting a permit to start construction.
- The project is fully funded, and construction will begin upon permit approval.

Biloxi Location:

- **Design Milestone:** The drawings of our new schematics are completed, reflecting our commitment to modern and efficient design.
- Pricing Phase: We expect to receive pricing by September 1st.
- Construction Phase: Construction will begin as the project becomes funded.
- The total project funds currently available are 511,831.

Bay St. Louis Location:

- **Design Milestone:** We anticipate the completion of all architectural drawings and schematics by September 1st.
- **Pricing Phase:** We will complete pricing as soon as schematics and designs are complete.

Church Online:

- Exciting Growth: We are on track to double our average weekend attendance in 2024 over 2023, with an average weekend attendance of 21,139 people.
- Global Reach: We are expanding in the U.S. and abroad with new volunteers serving in places like Utah, Iowa, Indiana, Florida, and Texas, as well as internationally in Uganda, England, Honduras, Pakistan, and more!
- Uganda Small Group: Our first small group in Uganda launched this fall, with 15 people going through Pastor Randy's Foundations curriculum!

Cape Town Location:

- Interest Meeting: We held our first interest meeting, and 100 people attended!
- First Mission Trip: A group of COTK College leaders traveled to Cape Town to serve the community and participated in outreach projects, playing a huge part in growing the audience of our first interest meeting!
- **Second Mission Trip:** A second mission trip with COTK Business Leaders will be traveling to Cape Town in October to host a business seminar for our Cape Town business leaders and connect with them in small groups.

Atlanta South Location:

- Student Impact: This fall, our Atlanta South Campus will begin NextGen school clubs in their community to reach high school students for Jesus.
- Global Impact: Atlanta South lead their first Global Mission trip to Juarez, Mexico. Our team of 13 came together to construct a home for a grandmother, her son, his wife, and their new baby. Previously residing in a tent, they now enjoy the comfort of a twobedroom home equipped with air conditioning and a bathroom.

He was not a believer but wanted to be open to his daughter's wishes. This family has been coming to church ever since. At first, he would barely come into the building. Then, slowly, he would sit on the couches out in the foyer. Then, he attended Next Steps to find out more about the church. Then he came to a Newcomers' Dinner. Next, he joined a small group! He started reading the Bible and asking questions. You could see God just chasing after him and changing his heart.

A few weeks ago, he attended a Men's Small Group, where he prayed and made a decision to accept Jesus as his Savior! He told me on the weekend that this church brought him back to God. I told him it was a divine appointment that his daughter was invited to VBS through her summer camp, and he agreed. The love and care that the church showed him, starting at that VBS, began his realization that God was chasing after him!

We had such a powerful week at our High School and Junior High Rev Conferences! There is nothing like seeing Jesus radically change students' lives. These conferences were marked by salvation, breakthrough, freedom, and healing for over 850 COTK Youth students from all of our campuses!

"In 2018, my father passed away from leukemia. Since then, I have suffered from depression and anxiety. I was on medication, but sadly, it didn't help much. During RevCon, a woman came up to me and offered to pray. I said yes just because I desperately needed help. Her prayer was amazing, and it was everything I needed to hear. That night, years' worth of anxiety and depression broke off of me like shackles, and I've never had more joy. Giving yourself to God is truly the best decision that you could ever make!"

"At the beginning of 2024, I was diagnosed with patella femoral disorder. My kneecap was loose, and the muscles in my leg weren't tight enough to keep it secure. This caused chronic knee pain, and my knees would constantly give out. On Day 2 of RevCon, my entire small group gathered and prayed for my knees to be healed. As soon as they finished, I could feel the muscles around my knee begin to tighten, and the chronic pain was gone. Throughout the rest of the day, my knees started to hurt again and begin to give out. I started to cry out to God... and knelt down to show my surrender to Jesus. When I stood up, the pain was gone, and I knew I was healed. By the end of RevCon, I was dancing and jumping with no pain and in ways I never could have before! Jesus is my healer."

Not only that, I've been trying to make it into an Architecture program at college, a program notorious for being difficult to get into. On Monday night, I was so moved that I re-dedicated my life to Jesus, and the next day, I gave up all my pain and hurt to him. I was ready to walk out anything God was calling me to. This is the best part: when I got home, I found out that only a few hours earlier, I had been accepted into the program. Praise the Lord. I cannot say how grateful I am for this week, and I can't wait to see what he has in store for me."

COTK College is a tremendous gift to our family. It's a path that has helped my daughter grow spiritually, mentally, and physically. It has helped her learn her purpose. She is a part of a forever family. I asked her if she could change her decision about where she would go, and she said she was right where she belongs She is thriving and so happy. I know that her foundation is rock solid. This is a path that a parent can only dream of and it's a reality. Literally brings me to tears. I also have a son who just graduated high school, and he is about to join his sister at COTK College now. My heart just overflows with gratitude and love!

I'm a COTK College student, and I've had the opportunity to serve for the past 2 months as an Intern at Operation Serve International. We partner with local churches to put on outreach events for the communities. We offer medical care, triage for blood pressure and blood sugar tests, optical care, haircuts, nails, legal advice, dental care, and more. Everything is free, but a church member or leader sits with each person who receives care to present the gospel to them! We have seen over 1500 decisions for Christ this summer! Each person who gives their life to Christ immediately has a church to attend and people to pour into them!

I personally have helped run the optical station, where we serve almost 100 people every day and give them glasses that they could not afford otherwise. We have seen many miracles: people who couldn't even see other people's faces clearly left with 20/20 or 20/30 vision.

I've learned so much interning internationally, from a deeper understanding of what it means to trust God to the practicals and flexibility needed to run a large organization reliant on volunteers. I've learned years' worth of lessons in two months. There is an opportunity for Gospel impact everywhere, and I'm excited to see what that looks like in my daily life at home. I feel equipped with wisdom I would not have otherwise, and I'm thankful.

Plan
